Fixed a small bug when approving a timecard with PTO only and also enhanced one of the endpoints in our API. New Features:

- 1. Employee Name sort - Instead of sorting by ID, you can also sort by employee name and selection will be saved:** Now when a user decides to sort by employee name, the selection will now be saved for that user, meaning if your last sort was by employee name, when you log off and log back on, the employee's name will be sorted by name instead of Id like it did before.

- 1. API - Added “BreakType” to the UserTimeLog endpoint for PUT method:** We have updated the PUT method in the UserTimeLog endpoint to allow time records to be edited

with break type information just like it is done in the POST method.
